TASK ORGANIZATION:

244th GHEIA Squadron - Maj. Albert E. Garvin, Commander.

1. GENERAL SITUATION:

The 244th GHEIA Squadron is responsible to train as a unit to accomplish its assigned mission. In order to accomplish this objective the 244th GHEIA Squadron will be ordered to active duty for a fifteen day period with the advisory unit, 2867th GHEIA Squadron, at Hamilton Air Force Base, California, 0001 hours 13 June 1959 through 2400 hours 27 June 1959.

a. Enemy Forces.

None.

b. Friendly Forces.

- (1) Hq., 4th Air Force, Hamilton Air Force Base.
- (2) 2867th GHEIA Squadron Hamilton Air Force Base.
- (3) 35th Communications Squadron Hamilton Air Force Base.
- (4) Base support services Hamilton Air Force Base.

c. Assumptions:

- (1) This plan will be implemented 0001 hours 13 June 1959.
- (2) One hundred (100) percent of officer assigned strength and One hundred (100) percent of airmen assigned strength will be present for active duty training.
- (3) Base service functions at Hamilton Air Force Base will be arranged for the 244th GEEIA Squadron by the 2867th GEEIA Squadron will receive on-the-job training.

2. MISSION:

To train all assigned personnel toward a state of combat readiness as soon as possible. This training will consist of practical training, on-the-job, with the 2867th GEEIA Squadron, and will further qualify all personnel to effectively render technical assistance for the preparation of CE schemes, site survey, engineering, installation, and rehabilitation of navigational aids, electronic and communications equipment for which GEEIA has the engineering and installation responsibility.

3. TASKS OF SUBORDINATE TEAMS:

- a. Develop teamwork, effective coordination, and an individual desire to accomplish assigned tasks.
- b. Qualify personnel in the established GEEIA methods and procedures used in performing installation engineering, installation, site survey, and facility rehabilitation projects.
- c. Familiarize team personnel in the preparation of records and reports utilized by GEEIA teams in installation engineering, installation, site survey, and rehabilitation projects.
- d. Qualify assigned personnel in the use of GEEIA job directives and installation job specifications.
- e. Develop leadership and supervisory abilities in team chiefs.
- f. Qualify designated teams on the job under actual installation conditions.

- g. Become familiar with requirements and methods of coordination various staff sections of an GENIA Squadron.
- h. Become familiar with the particular equipment in the category to which they are assigned i.e., radar, radio, power, inside and outside plant.
- i. Become familiar with the use and care of test equipment and hand power tools.
- j. Perform actual duties on the job with supervision as required by 2867th GENIA Group personnel.
- k. See annex A for detailed training outline.

4. ADMINISTRATIVE AND LOGISTICAL MATTERS:

a. General Instructions:

- (1) Each section and/or team chief will maintain a daily activities report of the activities performed by personnel assigned his section and team. The activities report will be forwarded to the division chief daily. The division chief will prepare a historical report covering the activities of his division during the active duty training period. This report will include a detailed account of type and quality of training received, any specific accomplishments by members of his division, and constructive criticism which may assist in correcting any deficiencies or improving training and operations procedures. The division historical report will be forwarded to the training officer the last day of the active duty training period. The training officer will consolidate all reports and prepare a Squadron historical report covering the above items not later than ten days after the active duty period.

5. COMMAND AND COMMUNICATION MATTERS:

a. Command.

- (1) Supervise and coordinate all administrative, logistical and training matters.

b. Communication.

- (1) In implementing this plan, direct communication between the 244th GENIA Squadron and the 2867th GENIA Squadron will be utilized.

OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

1. GENERAL

a. The 244th GEEIA Squadron will train at Hamilton Air Force Base, California, with personnel of the various teams being assigned for duty in the corresponding teams of the 2867th GEEIA Squadron.

b. When necessary, changes to the appendices to this annex will be made by amendments.

2. OBJECTIVES

a. The general objective of the 15-day active duty training period is to further the training of the 244th GEEIA Squadron teams and personnel in their ability to perform the assigned mission.

b. Specific training objectives and methods of attaining these objectives, by division and section, are given in the attached appendices.

3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

a. The Commander, 244th GEEIA Squadron, will be responsible for all technical and specialized training of assigned personnel.

b. The Senior Officer in Charge of the team or section will be responsible to the Commander for coordinating with the 2867th GEEIA Squadron specific training assignments for personnel under their supervision.

c. Due to the fluid schedule in engineering and installing C-2 facilities a detailed day by day training schedule is not practical. Squadron personnel will perform the routine duties of their advisory unit counterpart under the supervision of the 2867th GEEIA Squadron personnel.

4. GENERAL MILITARY TRAINING

General military training will not be conducted during this period.

5. BASIC

Airmen requiring basic training will not accompany the 244th GHEIA Squadron to the annual field training location. These Airmen will complete the required instruction elsewhere.

6. SPECIALIZED TRAINING

Specialized unit and individual training requirements are included in the appendices to this annex.
