

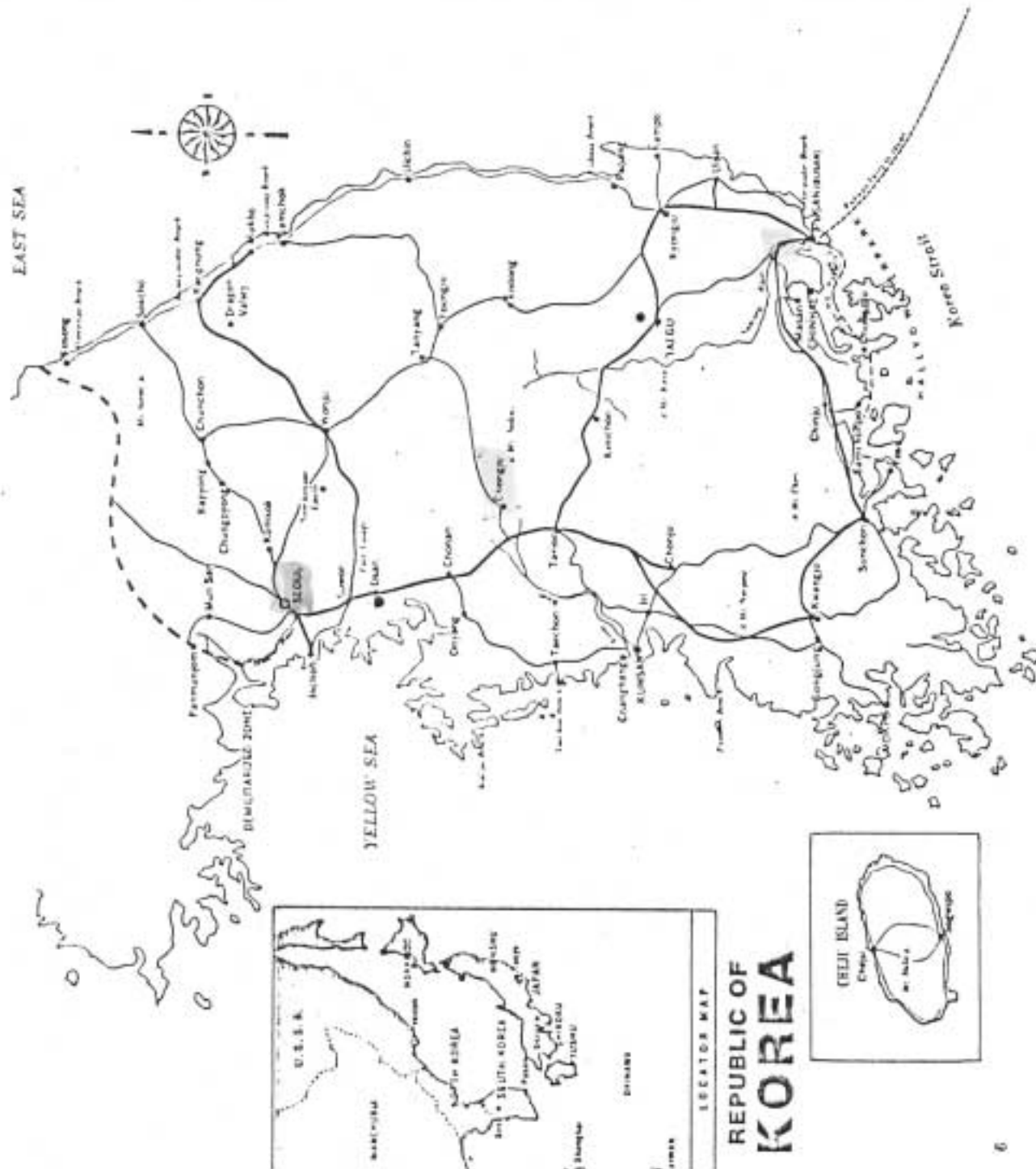
TEAM SPIRIT 80


